All UG (B.A, B.Com and B.Sc.) admissions will be governed by the directions of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University under the NEP 2020.

The syllabus and implementation of scheme is adopted as per the directions of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati

Subjects available- Major and Minor as per NEP-2020:

Eligibility for the B.Sc. First-year admission for the combination of the following subjects:

Students passing the HSSC Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics

OR

Students passing the HSSC Examination offering Vocational stream with Mathematics

OR

Students passing the HSSC examination (M.C.V.C. stream) with technical trades like Engineering and Technology Group.

<i>The Major Subject</i>	<i>Student shall have to select any Minor of the same faculty (other than Major in which admitted) available from the following Subject</i>
Physics Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics	Physics, Chemistry, Computer Science, Mathematics

Eligibility for the B.Sc. First-year admission for the combination of the following subjects:

Students passing the HSSC Examination with Chemistry, and Biology

OR

Students passing the HSSC Examination (M.C.V.C. stream) with technical trades like Para Medical Group, Agricultural Group, and Fisheries Group.

The Major Subject	Student shall have to select any Minor of the same faculty (other than Major in which admitted) available from the following Subject
Chemistry, Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biochemistry	Chemistry, Botany Zoology ,Microbiology, Biochemistry

Note: In addition to the eligibility above, following students will also be eligible for the admission to B.Sc.

- (i) Student who has successfully completed NSQF course level 4.0 from the Qualification Pack (QP) relevant or allied to Major Discipline/Subject in which he/she desire to seek admission.

OR

- (ii) Student who has successfully completed prerequisite (bridge course) with Course code 0-99 of National Credit Framework (NCrF) relevant or allied to Major Discipline/Subject in which he/she desire to seek admission.

UG Program B.A :-
